## Changes at Iceworld

As you are aware ISQ owns and operates the rinks at Boondall and Acacia Ridge, under the Iceworld banner. As well as providing affordable access to ice for skaters in Brisbane, the revenue from public skating at these rinks funds the development of the sport. In early 2017 Council completed a strategic review of Iceworld operations. Accordingly there have recently been several significant changes in our commercial operations.

## Appointment of Keith Fullerton as General Manager



After a recruitment process, Council has appointed Keith Fullerton as General Manager of Iceworld. Keith was a standout candidate from a strong field of applicants, having been GM of a leading golf club in New Zealand, CEO of Bowls Queensland and spent many years in sports development.

Immediately on his appointment, Council asked him to conduct his own review of the operations of Iceworld. The result has been a restructure of the facilities management function.

Council has set Keith and his team the challenge of upgrading the Boondall facilities in time for upcoming major competitions (see below). Without giving away his plans, you can expect significant improvements in the presentation and amenity of the Boondall rink by mid-year. Not to forget Acacia Ridge, an upgrade of the cooling tower is on the cards for 2017 as well.

## Departure of John Bradbury

As part of the organisational restructure following Keith's appointment, the role of Facilities Manager has been made redundant. John Bradbury completed his employment with Iceworld on the 3<sup>rd</sup> March. For over 25 years John has dedicated himself to maintaining the two rinks in Brisbane for the benefit of the ice skating community and we want to publicly acknowledge his contribution to the sport and wish him well in his future endeavours, which are rumoured to include caravanning.

## Appointment of Don Nicholls as Project & Maintenance Manager

We have been very fortunate as a sport to have had a President who is also an expert in project and maintenance management, from decades of experience with organisations such as Qantas and the Australian Defence Force.

The revitalisation of Iceworld is a strategic imperative to ISQ and to achieve this will require the dedication of a full time member of staff who can drive the upgrading of facilities and to support the General Manager with maintenance of the rinks. Council felt it was unreasonable to ask Don to work 40+ hours a week on a voluntary basis and after consultation with Don and Keith, the role of Project & Maintenance Manager has been offered to Don and he has accepted this offer.

## Junior Grand Prix—Boondall 21st—27th August

ISQ has been fortunate to have its bid for a JGP accepted by ISU. This will be the second time a JGP will be hosted in Brisbane. This will give the opportunity for local skaters and ISQ members to see world class competitive skating (singles and dance). Recently calls for participation in the organising committee were put out and the first meeting of the organising committee was held on the 8<sup>th</sup> March. It is vital that everyone get behind making this event a success - we need you to both volunteer for the event and to spread the word to your friends so we have maximum audience attendance. As entry is free this represents the best value sporting experience in Brisbane in 2017.

## Athlete & Coach Development Seminar - 10th—14th April

We are happy to announce that internationally renowned coaches Christy Krall and Eddie Shipstad have made themselves available to work with our skaters during the April School Holidays. We are also discussing with QPSA the potential to integrate a coach development seminar into this visit.

Christy Krall is well known for her work with Dart Fish video analysis software, while Eddie Shipstad is a heavily used harness coach by many top level athletes.

The seminar will be held at Iceworld Boondall from the 10<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup> of April from approximately 6:30 – 12:00 daily. Seminar is open to figure skaters with a minimum of Primary Free Skate AND Technical Patterns level. Ice Skating Queensland members only. ## Ice Sports Administration Development Seminar - Boondall - July 2017

ISQ will be running a weekend development seminar for officials and administrators of ice sports clubs. This will be open to all affiliate clubs as well as other ice sports associations. On Saturday, a leading educator on not-for-profit governance will be providing intensive training in the role and duties of association officials and committee members, including practical advice on how to run a committee.

On the Sunday, we will be running an ice sports planning day for ISQ, which will include participation by affiliated club representatives, Iceworld management, ISA representatives, Athlete Development Committee and professional associations such as QPSA. This will include sessions on club development, athlete development, the best use of our facilities, managing relationship with coaches and coaching associations, running competitions, and developing the sport towards 2020. A formal announcement and invitation will be sent out shortly.
