# PARTICIPATION IN INTERSTATE COMPETITIONS

### POLICY OBJECTIVE

To support a structured and systematic development of the sport of figure skating in Queensland.

### POLICY

All athletes or synchronised skating teams wishing to represent Queensland in interstate competitions must be nominated or endorsed by Ice Skating Queensland Inc. (ISQ)

To qualify for nomination, the athletes must be:

- (a) current financial members of ISQ;
- (b) eligible to compete in the event (age and/or test level)

In the case of events with limited numbers of entries the athletes may also have to participate in selection trials that will determine the final nominations.

Where the interstate competition announcement does not require the State Association to process entries, individual athletes and teams entering that particular event must notify ISQ Administration of their intention to participate. Such applications must be made in advance by the athlete or team submitting their entry forms.

### REASONING

In order to discharge its governing responsibilities, ISQ must be formally advised of and approve the participation of Queensland skaters in any competitive events outside the State.
