<b>Ice Dimensions</b>	All competition events will take place at Iceworld™ Boondall, which is an indoor ice rink with an ice surface of 60 metres x 30 metres.

<b>Results</b>	The IJS (ISU Judging System) will be used for all Divisions. Open Marking Results displayed or announced will remain provisional until the results are certified by the segment Referee and Technical Controller on the official result form.

<b>Membership Requirements</b>	<p>At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their State Association and an affiliated club.</p> <p>Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p>
<b>Insurance/Liability</b>	<p>All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover.</p> <p>Ice Skating Australia &amp; Ice Skating Queensland Inc. assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.</p>
<b>Eligibility to Compete</b>	<p>Skaters must have passed the relevant ISA test level at the close of entries.</p>
<b>Covid-19 Safe Plan</b>	<p>This event will be held under any &amp; all strict <b>Covid-19 Safe Plans</b> applicable.</p>

<b>Entry Conditions</b>	<p>Entries will not be considered complete unless;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Completed Entry Form is received</li> <li>○ Full Payment is paid</li> <li>○ Planned Program Content Details / Music Details / .mp3 music file &amp; current Sports Integrity Certificate are submitted</li> </ul> <p>* Late entries will be accepted on double the Entry Fee but will not be accepted after the Draw.</p>
<b>Coach Accreditation</b>	<p>Only coaches accredited with the Australian Coaching Council may obtain competition accreditation. In the case of an international coach who has not had the opportunity to pursue ACC accreditation, the coach may make written application to APSA <a href="https://apsa.net.au">apsa.net.au</a> seeking APSA endorsement for the provision of competition accreditation upon review of evidence of qualifications submitted in English. All coaches must have a Queensland Working with Children Blue Card.</p>

<b>Refunds</b>	<p>Refund only with a medical certificate provided <u>before the draw</u>. No refund permitted after the draw.</p> <p>A 10% fee to cover administration costs will be deducted from the refund.</p>
<b>Music Provision and File Naming</b>	<p>All competitors must upload their .mp3 music file at time of entry.</p> <p>Uploaded music must be named as per ISA Music Provision Protocol. <a href="http://www.isq.org.au/uploads/ISA%20Music%20Protocol.pdf">http://www.isq.org.au/uploads/ISA%20Music%20Protocol.pdf</a></p> <p>All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on CD or USB. The CD / USB must contain only one track and must be marked as follows:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Competitor's name.</li> <li>• Event Section, e.g. Elementary Women</li> <li>• Program identification, e.g. Short Program</li> <li>• Exact running time of the music (not skating time)</li> </ul> <p>Mobile phones will NOT be accepted for backup use.</p> <p>Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs &amp; Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.</p> <p>Each program (short program, free skating, short dance, free dance) must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music. The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of competition. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or reused.</p>
<b>PPC / Music Details /Sports Integrity Certificate</b>	<p>The Planned Program Content, Music information and current Sports Integrity Certificate must be submitted at time of entry.</p>
<b>Schedule</b>	<p>A preliminary schedule will be available at <a href="https://isq.org.au/qld-championships.php">https://isq.org.au/qld-championships.php</a></p> <p>A detailed schedule of events will be provided following the closing of entries and will be published on the LOC website <a href="https://isq.org.au/qld-championships.php">https://isq.org.au/qld-championships.php</a></p>
<b>Awards/Trophies</b>	<p>Trophies will be awarded to first, second and third place competitors respectively in all sections.</p>

<b>Program Timing</b>	Program timing starts from the moment the skater or team begins to move or to skate until arriving at a complete stop at the end of the program.
<b>Event Warm Up</b>	<u>As per ISU rules</u>
<b>Doping</b>	Doping tests may be conducted in accordance with the ISA Doping Policy, ISU Rule 139 and/or subsequent ISU Communications.
